General Info: The building is of historical significance and it therefore heritage listed. The venue

can accommodate 120 on the deck and 200 inside (depending on setup). The building is available for hire with no tables or chairs. There is no air-conditioning in the building, however there are fans. There is a track lighting system and an art

display hanging facilities on the walls.



As the Sugar Wharf is timber structure no cooking, smoking or naked flames are permitted. All cooking must be done on the concrete area. Most catering companies are aware of this restriction and are able to accommodate with this set-up.

Due to its location on the Port Douglas waterfront and with most functions being held on the deck area there are noise restrictions in place.


Car Park: A large public car park is located close to Sugar Wharf where there are accessible

parking bays available. An uncovered drop off point is available close to the access

area to Sugar Wharf.

Facilities: Entry to the Sugar Wharf is generally level with concrete and timber flooring and

decking. There is no operational kitchen, only a room with a sink and small bench.



Sanitary Facilities:

There are two toilets in the building so it is advisable for large events to utilise the public toilets close by. One of the toilets within Sugar Wharf is wheelchair accessible.
