

## Minutes of the Special Meeting of Council 20 December 2007 commencing at 3:14 pm

#### **PRESENT**

#### **APOLOGY**

"By Leigh Bernhardt's own admission that the affected staff were given a copy of the outcome of the investigation as it related to them individually and there is no certainty that a claim could be made in the future. Therefore that Terry Melchert should be given the information that relates to the outcomes of the investigation that pertains solely to him"
