30 April 2024	6.7 Cyclone Jasper Expenditure to March 2024	Cr Noli asked whether there will be any more approval of expenditure recommendations coming to Council.	The Cyclone Jasper Expenditure reports will continue until all of the Counter Disaster and Emergency expenditure has been completed and reported, will be at least a few more months.
30 April 2024	6.9 Capital Works Progress Report for October 2023 to March 2024	Cr Zammataro asked for information about delays to light pole installation at Coronation Park.	Following contractor award in February 2023, lighting equipment was delivered to site in October 2023. The lighting equipment assembly on site was not completed before Tropical Cyclone Jasper and the subsequent flooding in December 2023 setback assembly completion. Further, the lighting was subjected to ground water so was required to be sent away for confirmation testing. The equipment has now been returned to site and installation of the fully assembled equipment has commenced on 3 May 2024.
