Chemicals/solvents under 25L	✓	✓	✓	✓	Accepted in quantities of under 25L per visit. Must be in the original containers and clearly labelled.
Clean Fill	✗	✗	✗	✗	Not accepted at any Transfer Station.

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Compressed air/gas tanks & cylinders (i.e. Oxy bottles, dive tanks etc.)	✗	✗	✗	✗	Not accepted at Transfer Stations. Disposal available at place of purchase.
Construction & Demolition waste	✓	✗	✗	✗	Clean, separated concrete and bricks attract a lower fee than mixed C&D. See Council's Fees and Charges for more information.
Cooking Oil	✗	✗	✗	✗	Not accepted at any Transfer Station. Arrange directly with a Commercial Contractor.
Electronic Waste (E-Waste)	✓	✓	✓	✓	Computers, TVs, and approved peripherals by the E-Waste contractor
Engine Oil	✓	✗	✗	✓	Accepted in quantities of under 25L per visit.
EPIRB/Flares	✗	✗	✗	✗	Not accepted at any Transfer Station. Disposal available at the Coast Guard.
Fire extinguishers	✓	✗	✗	✗	Limited to 1 per visit.
Fridge, freezer, aircon, or other item with or without refrigerant	✓	✓	✗	✓	eg: Fridge, freezer, aircon, heat pump
Furniture, broken household items etc.	✓	✓	✓	✓	Assessed and approved reusable items can be donated to the Scrap Shack at Killaloe Transfer Station.
Green waste (from electric ant areas)	✓	✓	✗	✗	Green waste from electric ant areas must be clean and separated from other green waste and other waste types. Green waste from declared weed areas is not accepted.

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Green waste (not from electric ant areas)	✓	✓	✓	✗	Must be clean and separated from other waste types. Green waste from declared weed areas is not accepted.
LPG gas bottles	✓	✓	✓	✓	Limited to 2 bottles per visit. Return/disposal program also available at place of purchase.
Mattress	✓	✓	✓	✓	Limited to two mattresses per visit. A bed base is not considered to be a mattress and is charged as Mixed Waste.
Mobile Phones	✓	✓	✓	✓	Recycling of mobile phones available through Mobile Muster program only. More info at www.mobilemuster.com.au
Mulch sales	✓	✓	✗	✗	Free mechanical loading of mulch is available at Killaloe Transfer Station on Tuesdays & Thursdays between 9am - 4pm. Self loading is available during normal operating hours.
Oversized metal items	✓	✗	✗	✗	eg: boats, caravans, skip bins etc. By prior arrangement with Council only.
Paint	✓	✓	✓	✓	Accepted in quantities of under 25L per visit.
Recyclables (plastic bottles & containers, glass jars and bottles, metal tins and cans).	✓	✓	✓	✓	Must be clean and separated with lids removed. Paper and cardboard are not to be comingled. Disposal method of recyclables is different at each Transfer Station. Please contact the Council for further information if required.
Scrap metal	✓	✓	✓	✓	Standard sized loose items only. Newell, Daintree & Cow Bay in vehicles < 4.5t GVM/GCM only.

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Scrap Metal - oversize	✓	✗	✗	✗	May be accepted at Killaloe Transfer Station by prior arrangement with Council - ph: 4099 9444.
Scrap Shack/Re-use items	✓	✗	✗	✗	Items are to be assessed by staff prior to being accepted. Items left are for personal, domestic or household use only and any commercial use of items is prohibited, including the on-selling of items.
Sharps	✗	✗	✗	✗	Not accepted at any Transfer Station. Disposal available at GP Clinics and Hospitals.
Treatable waste	✓	✗	✓	✓	eg: food scraps and general mixed kitchen waste.
Tyres	✓	✗	✗	✓	Limited to 5 per visit. Tyres with rim or dirty attract a higher fee.
Vehicle body (standard)	✓	✓	✗	✓	Car bodies must not contain waste or any other items and must have all fluids removed. Includes four attached tyres.
Vehicle body (small)	✓	✓	✗	✓	(e.g. ride-on mower, golf cart, motorbike, single axle box trailer). Items must not contain waste or other items. Includes up to four attached tyres.
Whitegoods	✓	✓	✗	✓	eg: oven, washing machine - that is not designed to hold refrigerant gas
