

## Alexandra Range

- When work first commenced, there were 26 landslips sites identified.
- Repairs have now been completed at 21 sites.
- The five remaining sites are: 3b, 5, 6, 7 & 8.
- The aim is to complete all repairs by end May 2025.
- The length and weight restrictions will remain, and vehicles must be no wider than 2.7 metres.
- Vehicles exceeding length and width guidelines will not get through and pose a safety risk to workers on site.
- The damaged lane at site 8 needs to be cut back to complete the repair works, removing any flexibility to move barriers for the next eight weeks.

## Noah Creek Bypass

- The bypass was closed last week, and machinery was on site Monday 13 January 2025.
- Going forward, given the expected increase in the volume of trucks needing to use the bypass, arrangements will be made to leave a machine at the location for the foreseeable future.
- When the bypass is damaged by flood water, or by the volume of traffic, an operator will be deployed from the HEH construction to do repairs and this will minimize the amount of time the bypass is unusable.

## Landslip Sites – South of Daintree River

- The tender for the repair of landslips south of the Daintree River has been released. There are eight landslips in total:
  - Three on Stewart Creek Road, Stewart Creek Valley
  - Two on Upper Daintree Road, Upper Daintree
  - Two on Old Forestry Road, Whyanbeel
  - One on Chooks Ridge Road, Shannonnvale
- Tenders close 12 February 2025.

## Landslip Sites - Cape Tribulation Bloomfield Rd

- The tender for the repair of landslips on various sites on Cape Tribulation Bloomfield Road has been released.
- There are ten landslips in total.
- Tenders close 12 February 2025.

## CREB Track

- Douglas Shire Council has closed the CREB Track for the season.

## Road Conditions

### 16 January 2025

**Cape Tribulation Road** is open to all vehicles through to just past Cape Trib Beach House. A 4WD is needed to travel through to Emmagen Creek.

There are some weight, time and length restrictions.

- **Alexandra Range** – Open 5am to Midnight. If towing a trailer, caravan or campervan, total length cannot exceed 15.1 metres.
- Rigid vehicles cannot exceed 12.5 metres in length.
- Maximum weight of vehicles is 25 tonnes.
- **Maximum width 2.7 metres. NEW**
- Noah Creek Bridge has a weight restriction of 16 tonnes.
- **Noah Causeway** – Open. No load limit.
- **Noah Range** – Open 5am to Midnight.

**Cape Tribulation Bloomfield Road** is open to 4WDs.

- There are no weight or time restrictions, however the road is unsuitable for towing trailers, campervans or caravans.
- After the cyclone, emergency repairs were done, and it opened to 4WD vehicles in late June 2024.
- The permanent repairs have yet to be completed so the road is rough and is subject to flash flooding. Please check the weather before travelling and drive to conditions.

**Zig Zag Road** open to 4WD vehicles and there are no weight limits.

**China Camp Road** open to 4WD vehicles only. There is a 5 tonnes load limit on the concrete section from Ayton.

**Ten Mile Road** is open to 4WD vehicles only.

**CREB Track** - CLOSED.
