Cape Tribulation Road Cape Tribulation Bloomfield Road

Alexandra Range

- Contractors are on track to complete work in early May 2025.
- NQ Asphalt Pty Ltd will commence pavement repairs as from Monday 28 April 2025. Refer image below.
- The Traffic Control point will be re-established to just north of the Tulip Oak Road turnoff.
- Contractors will be setting up the site and completing toolbox talks, and site walk through to identify lay down area for machines, so minimal work will be done on Monday.
- Paving will commence Tuesday 29 April, and weather permitting, will be completed within a week.
- There will be delays, so please factor this into travel plans.



Noah Bridge & Temporary Bypass

- Tender evaluations have been completed.
- Funding submission is with Queensland Recovery Authority (QRA) for approval.
- Cultural Heritage Management Plan is signed off.
- Council is working with Fisheries and State Assessment and Referral Agency to finalise the design of the bypass.

Road Conditions 23 April 2025

Cape Tribulation Road is open to all vehicles through to just past Cape Trib Beach House. A 4WD is needed to travel through to Emmagen Creek.

There are some weight, time and length restrictions.

- Alexandra Range Open 5am to Midnight. If towing a trailer, caravan or campervan, total length cannot exceed 15.1 metres.
- Rigid vehicles cannot exceed 12.5 metres in length.
- Maximum weight of vehicles is 25 tonnes.
- Maximum width 2.7 metres.
- No cyclists permitted [can hitch a ride with traveller with a ute to carry bike.]
- Noah Creek Bridge has a weight restriction of 16 tonnes and a 5km/hr speed limit
- Noah Causeway Intermittent depending on weather and truck movements. No load limit.
- Noah Range Open 24/7

Cape Tribulation Bloomfield Road - 4WDs.

- There are no weight or time restrictions, however the road is unsuitable for towing trailers, campervans or caravans.
- After the cyclone, emergency repairs were done, and it opened to 4WD vehicles in late June 2024.
- The permanent repairs have yet to be completed so the road is rough and is subject to flash flooding. Please check the weather before travelling and drive to conditions.

Zig Zag Road open to 4WD vehicles and there are no weight limits.

China Camp Road open to 4WD vehicles only. There is a 5 tonnes load limit on the concrete section from Ayton.

Ten Mile Road is open to 4WD vehicles only.

CREB Track – CLOSED for the season.

Noah Range Landslip

- Sealing of the road at the base of the landslip has been completed.
- Rain is slowing down work however the aim is for the repairs to be completed by end of September weather permitting.

Daintree River Ferry Contract

- Tenders have now closed.
- Offers are currently being assessed and will be presented to Council at the Ordinary Council meeting scheduled for Tuesday 27 May 2025.

ANZAC Day 4am Ferry Start

- Daintree Ferry services will start at 4am, Friday 25 April to accommodate those who want to attend the Anzac Day Dawn Service in Cow Bay.
- Traffic control will open at 4am on Alexandra Range to accommodate those travelling from the south.

Cape Tribulation Bloomfield Road

- Tenders for all repairs on Cape Tribulation Bloomfield Road, including concrete pavements, landslips and unsealed road surfaces, have been evaluated and recommendations to award have been approved.
- All contracts are expected to be awarded and finalised early next week.

Betterment Funds

- Council has lodged a submission for improvements to road infrastructure throughout the shire.
- Only projects approved for Reconstruction of Essential Public Assets are eligible.
- Cape Tribulation Bloomfield Road sections include
 - Concrete approaches and drainage either side of Collins Creek.
 - Three sites identified for concrete pavement on Donovans Range.
 - $\circ~$ The aim is to join up existing concrete sections.
- Concrete pavement on two sections approaching Woobadda Creek Bridge.
- Concrete pavement on sections south and north of Luana Creek.
- To the north, the application is for the concrete pavement to meet existing pavement so to better protect the road which runs along the edge of Woobadda Creek.
- None of the projects are guaranteed as it is a competitive process.

Lee's Bridge and Taylors Crossing

Stewart Creek Valley

- Evaluation of tenders has been completed.
- QRA has approved the funding submissions, allowing the contract to be awarded next week.
- In preparation of Lee's Bridge, load testing was completed on Stewart's Creek Bridge.
- This was done to confirm the bridge's rating of T44 loading allowing heavy machinery required for Lee's Bridge reconstruction work to cross the bridge.



Deadline Looming to get New Ferry Card

- Please renew your card on or before 30 April 2025.
- From 1 May 2025, any locals who have not renewed their ferry card will need to pay the standard fare.
