

Number of crocodile sightings reported



*Douglas Shire Council consists of the popular tourist destination Four Mile beach whose expanse is designated 'Zone D: Targeted Beach Management Zone'. Other prominent management zones include 'Zone C: Targeted Management Zones' located within Ferndale Lake Port Douglas, the upper Mossman River past Foxton Beach, and the Newell Beach boat ramp. One crocodile was released after capture in Coopers Creek, Cape Tribulation in 2016 during a critical incident response where the crocodile was inadvertently trapped whilst targeting a declared problem crocodile. Average size of crocodile removed is not an indication of average size of crocodiles in an area but rather more indicative of management policies for a region.
