Alexandra Range

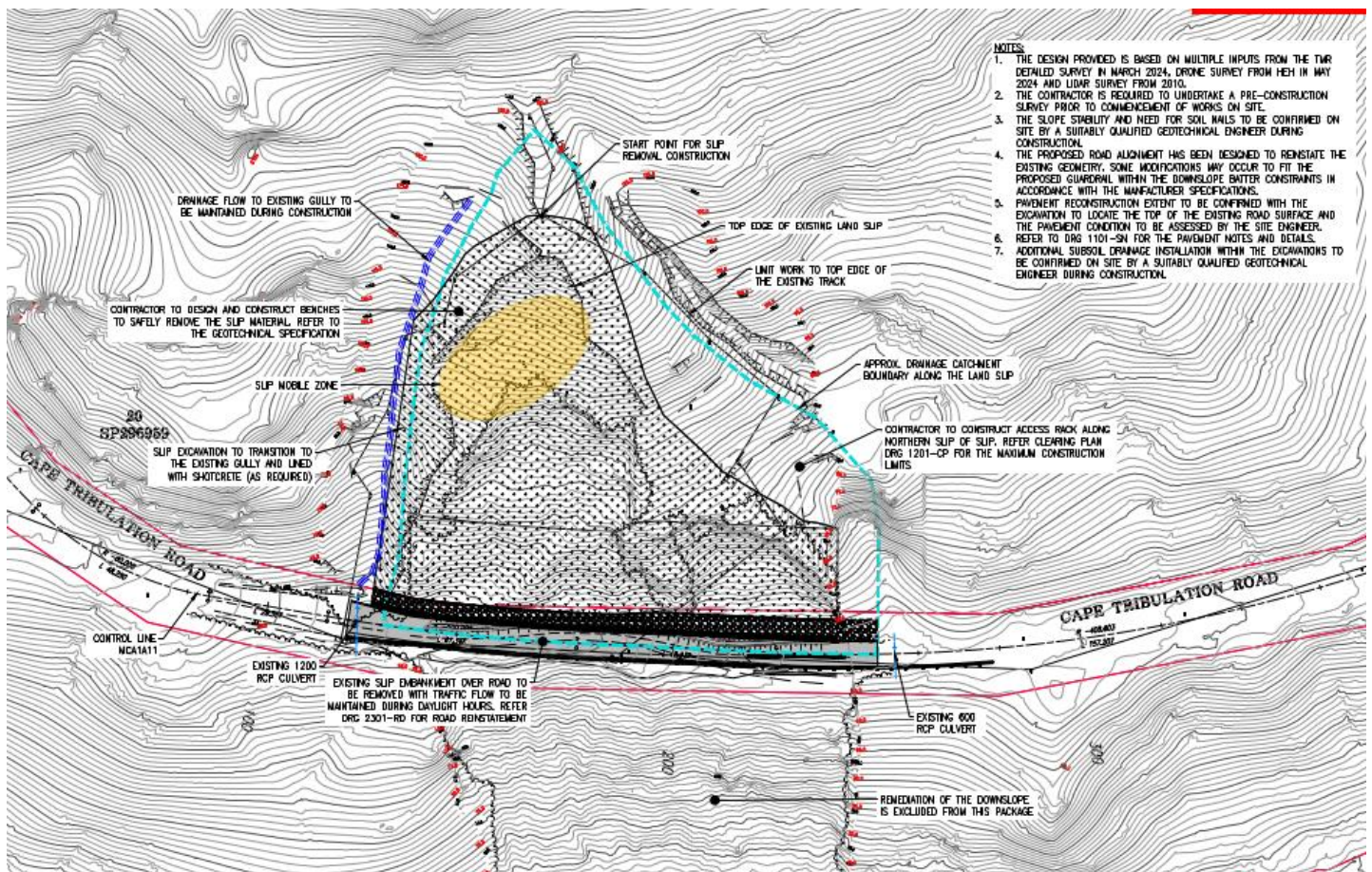
- Wet weather has slowed progress.
