<b>Project Name:</b>	<i>Warner Street Upgrade Project</i>

<b>Description:</b>	<p>The need to upgrade Warner Street between Owen and Grant is required for three reasons:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Without re-engineering to accommodate the shallow root system of the existing trees, their health will continue to decline suffer</li> <li>▪ Damage to public infrastructure including the road and drains caused by roots will continue if nothing is done, adding to maintenance costs</li> <li>▪ Residents and business operators in Warner Street will continue to experience issues with water not draining away leaving pools of stagnant, smelly water, gutters and drains filling with leaves, and roots causing trip hazards.</li> </ul> <p>Douglas has awarded a contract for consultants to prepare several solutions, which will cover:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Roadway</li> <li>▪ Streetscape</li> <li>▪ Street lighting</li> <li>▪ Landscaping</li> <li>▪ Shared pathways</li> <li>▪ Cycle lanes</li> <li>▪ Residential and Commercial parking</li> <li>▪ Residential and Commercial crossovers</li> <li>▪ Drainage upgrades</li> </ul>
