

Road Conditions – 1 July 2024

Cape Tribulation Road is open to all vehicles through to just past Cape Trib Beach House.

There are some weight, time and length restrictions.

- Alexandra Range – Open 5am to Midnight. If towing a trailer, caravan or campervan, total length cannot exceed 15.1 metres.
- Rigid vehicles cannot exceed 12.5 metres in length.
- Maximum weight of vehicles is 25 tonnes.
- Noah Creek Bridge has a weight restriction of 16 tonnes.
- Noah Range – Open 5am to Midnight.

Cape Tribulation Bloomfield Road is open to 4WD vehicles.

- This includes the stretch of road between Cape Trib Beach House and Emmagen Creek.
- There are no weight or time restrictions, however the road is unsuitable for towing trailers, campervans or caravans.

Take Care on The Track

If you intend to drive Cape Tribulation Bloomfield Road, please check weather conditions beforehand. While emergency repairs have been done to allow the road to be opened, the permanent repairs are some way off.

In the interim, gravel coverage on some sections have been washed away and as such, the road can become impassable after rain.

Last week, a traveller towing a campervan ignored the big red sign, and in the vicinity of Woobadda Creek, jack-knifed the campervan, damaging his vehicle and making it difficult for other travellers to pass.

Daintree Ferry

Council invited EOIs for operators to supply a vessel and operate the service in November last year, generating three responses.

There's been no further developments on this. Council has, however, allocated \$150,000 for ferry maintenance in the 24/25 budget.
