Alexandra Range

- Four sites 4, 8a, 10 & 11 are almost complete just awaiting installation of guide railing.
- Council did an inspection last week to make sure all construction sites were tidy and ready for adverse weather during the shutdown period.

Noah Range Landslip

- HEH has completed installation of the second layer of shipping containers.
- The contractor has done a good amount of work descaling and getting rid of some of the larger debris on the site.
- HEH will have 18,000 litres of fuel stored on the north side of the landslip for the shutdown period.
- They will also have staff located on the north side.
- If there is a big weather event, repair crews can go at it from both sides to open the road quickly.
- The radar will remain operating, to provide forewarning of any slips on the site.

Routine Inspections

- These will be done on both ranges following rainfall measuring over 200mm within a 24-hour period.
- Staff are on call over the Christmas / New Year period to communicate any road closure information or changes to ferry services.

Noah Creek Bypass

- The heavy vehicle bypass was repaired and reopened Friday 13 December.
- It has since closed and remains closed until further advice.

Daintree Ferry Christmas Day

Ferry services will operate as normal from 5am to midnight on 25 December 2024.

Road Conditions 23 December 2024



Cape Tribulation Road is open to all vehicles through to just past Cape Trib Beach House. A 4WD is needed to travel through to Emmagen Creek.

There are some weight, time and length restrictions.

- Alexandra Range Open 5am to Midnight. If towing a trailer, caravan or campervan, total length cannot exceed 15.1 metres.
- Rigid vehicles cannot exceed 12.5 metres in length.
- Maximum weight of vehicles is 25 tonnes.
- Noah Creek Bridge has a weight restriction of 16 tonnes.
- Noah Causeway CLOSED. When operational, there is no load limit.
- Noah Range Open 5am to Midnight.

Cape Tribulation Bloomfield Road is open to 4WDs.

 There are no weight or time restrictions, however the road is unsuitable for towing trailers, campervans or caravans.

Zig Zag Road open to 4WD vehicles and there are no weight limits.

China Camp Road open to 4WD vehicles only. There is a 5 tonnes load limit on the concrete section from Ayton.

Ten Mile Road is open to 4WD vehicles only.

CREB Track is open to 4WDs - experienced drivers only, and please check weather conditions.
