

Road Conditions – 24 June 2024

Cape Tribulation Road is open to all vehicles through to just past Cape Trib Beach House.

There are some weight, time and length restrictions.

- Alexandra Range – Open 5am to Midnight. If towing a trailer, caravan or campervan, total length cannot exceed 15.1 metres.
- Rigid vehicles cannot exceed 12.5 metres in length.
- Maximum weight of vehicles is 25 tonnes.
- Noah Creek Bridge has a weight restriction of 16 tonnes.
- Noah Range – Open 5am to Midnight.

Cape Tribulation Bloomfield Road

- Open to 4WD vehicles.
- This includes the stretch of road between Cape Trib Beach House and Emmagen Creek.
- There are no weight or time restrictions, however the road is unsuitable for towing trailers, campervans or caravans.

Alexandra Range

The current practical completion date for Site 1 is early July. Sites 2 & 3 will be towards the end of July.

The contractor has had issues with the challenging site conditions and anchoring of the micropiles.

The team is working on permits and further Geotech testing for the other 11 sites.

Noah Range Monitoring

There has been no movement of the landslip detected by the radar, coinciding with the dry weather.

Noah Creek Crossing

Design and approvals are progressing. The heavy vehicle by-pass has re-opened. This is only for construction vehicles.

Cape Tribulation Bloomfield Road

The Emergency Works to get Cape Tribulation Bloomfield Road open have been completed.

The project team is already working on the submission for the permanent repairs of the road.

The submission for funds under the Reconstruction of Essential Public Assets (REPA) is expected to be lodged with Queensland Recovery Authority mid July 2024.

CREB Track

- Repairs to the CREB Track have been started from the northern end.
- Good progress has been made as the machines have travelled about six kilometres as of last Friday, and we expected to do a few more days work before having to return early this week.

Signs for Alexandra Range

Today signs will be put up at the ferry and in Cow Bay to alert visitors to length restrictions on the range.
