
Important Notice for Travellers to Cape Tribulation.

Major repair work on Noah Creek Bridge
Monday 13 October to Wednesday 22 October 2025

Road Closures

- Bridge Closure: Cape Tribulation Road just north of Thornton Beach (Noah Creek Bridge) will be closed overnight from 6:30pm to 6am every day during the works.
- Causeway Access: The adjacent causeway will close each night at 8:00pm and reopen at 6am, with 4WD access only – it is not suitable for 2WD vehicles.

Planning Travel

- Travellers need to reach Noah Creek before 6:30pm, if planning to go to Cape Tribulation.
- If travelling to north Cape Tribulation, you will need to be at the Daintree Ferry **no later 5:15pm**, to be absolutely sure you will arrive before the road closes at 6:30pm.
- If returning to Cairns or Port Douglas, **plan to leave Cape Tribulation at 6pm** to be absolutely sure you will arrive at Noah Creek before the road closes at 6:30pm.
- Guests staying at Cape Tribulation, booked on early morning tours from Port Douglas, or flights out of Cairns, need to note the road will not open until 6am and make plans accordingly.

No Exceptions

The work to restore the bridge's load rating to 16 tonnes is urgent and cannot be delayed. Travellers who arrive after 6:30pm or before 6am, will not be able to cross Noah Bridge and there can be no exceptions.

- Travellers going in either direction, will not be able to cross the bridge after 6:30pm.
- 4WDs will be able to access the adjacent causeway up until 8pm, but travellers should note this will be subject to any high flow levels which are sometimes experienced in Noah's Creek.
- Travellers in 2WDs are not able to access the adjacent causeway at any time.
