

## **Whyanbeel Road Closure at Causeway No. 1 Wednesday 3 June 2020 – 9am to 1pm**

As you will be aware, Kenmac Constructions started work on a new bridge last month, creating a temporary side track to provide access for residents and contractors during construction.

On 3 June, the deck of the new bridge is scheduled for installation. This will be a big operation with eight girders, each 18½ metres in length, to be installed by a crane on site.

Ergon Energy will also be on site to lower the High Voltage power lines and reinstate once decking is in place.

Four Girders will be transported from Cairns on the day and lifted directly into place and then the four girders currently stored on site will be lifted into place.

There will a lot of equipment on site, crane and semi-trailers, etc. and to ensure the safety of everyone, the temporary side track will be closed to all vehicles and pedestrians for a maximum of four hours while the girders are installed.

The road will be closed from 9am to 1pm.
