# 5.7. APPROVAL TO EXECUTE FORM PART C - TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE CONNOLLY ROAD ABUTTING LOT 193 N15751 DESCRIBED AS LOT A.

## RECOMMENDATION

#### That Council:

- 1. Resolves to allow the an application to be lodged with the Department of Natural Resources, Mines and Energy to apply for a temporary road closure being part of Connolly Road abutting the north western boundary of Lot 193 N15751, described as Lot A on Drawing CNS17/027CP
- 2. Delegate authority to the Chief Executive Officer in accordance with section 257 of the *Local Government Act 2009* to finalize any and all matters with this application being lodged with the Department of Natural Resources, Mines and Energy, including the execution of the Form C as being owners of the road reserve.

## **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

It is a requirement for all applications made to the Department of Natural Resources Mines and Energy (DNRME) under the *Land Act 1994* over State land for the applicant to first obtain Council's consent as owners of the Road Reserve indicating that Council has no objections to the application being made.

A request has been received from the owners of Lot 193 N15751 Connolly Road for Council to consent to an application being lodged with DNRME for the proposed temporary road closure of Connolly's Road. The proposed temporary road closure has an area of approximately 7,070 M2 which is planted out with sugar cane. The temporary road closure will be known as Lot A which will abut the north western boundary of lot 193 N15751.

Council will be provided an opportunity in due course to respond to DNRME regarding the application.

## BACKGROUND

By Council providing the applicant with an executed Form Part C, Council is not consenting to the application itself, it is just consenting to the applicant proceeding to lodge an application with DNRME.

## COMMENT

As this proposal is a temporary road closure, the underlying nature of the area will remain as a dedicated road. If Council requires the temporary closed road shown as Lot A (attachment A) to be re-opened, Officers can advise DNRME and the cancellation of the road licence will

commence. Normally DNRME would provide the licensee with three months written notice of a cancellation.

Council to provide consent by way of an executed Form C, to enable the application to be lodged with DNRME
