

6.1. INSTALLATION OF "NO CAMPING" SIGNS TOWNSHIP OF WANGHETTI

NOTICE OF MOTION:

I hereby give Notice of my intention to move the following Motion at the Council meeting scheduled for Tuesday 3 November 2015:-

"that Council install "No Camping" signs at the entrances to the Township of Wanghetti in line with the signs installed at other beachside townships."

BACKGROUND:

There is already at least one, albeit poorly maintained, sign at Wanghetti and it is but reasonable that this sign be replaced and the township receive similar signage to that installed at other beach side townships.

CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER'S COMMENT:

Officers advise as follows:-

1. On 17 August 2015 officers ordered a number of temporary corflute signs and installed them at hot spot areas, including Wangetti;
2. Shortly after, officers noticed that the sign at South Wangetti had been removed. A replacement was promptly erected;
3. On 21 September an order was placed for 5 permanent "No Camping" signs. Signs were delivered in the last week;
4. Officers are currently seeking a quotation and schedule to install signage at South Wangetti and replace the defaced temporary sign at North Wangetti;
5. Officers contacted the administrator of the Wikicamps application and advised that an entry titled "Wangetti Free Camping" should be removed, and further, that no "free" camping existed in the Douglas Shire. Officers regularly peruse the application to ensure information is correct; and
6. A check of Council records shows that 5 campers were moved on from Wangetti for the month of October to date.
