# 7.10. AMENDMENT DECLARATION OF SEWER AND WATER SERVICE AREAS WITHIN DOUGLAS SHIRE - OCTOBER 2025

#### **RECOMMENDATION**

#### **That Council:**

- 1. Resolves that Douglas Shire Council is the service provider for the provision of reticulated water and sewerage services within Douglas Shire;
- 2. Resolves to declare the revised maps attached indicate the service areas within the coloured boundary (relevant area) for reticulated water and sewerage within Douglas Shire; and
- 3. Delegates authority to the Chief Executive Officer under Section 257 of the *Local Government Act 2009* to administer all matters in relation to the above.

#### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

Douglas Shire Council acts as the local government entity supplying water and sewerage services in part of the local government area. Under the *Water Supply (Safety and Reliability) Act 2008*, the Council is required to declare retail water and sewerage service areas and then publish the declaration and service area maps on the website. The service area maps must be reviewed and if required, updated by the registered service provider at least annually. Declaration of service areas provide the basis for a guarantee of connection for all premises in the service area. Additionally, the declared service areas enable service providers to recover reasonable costs from customers for ensuring their networks are designed for and can accommodate the service requirement of all premises in the service area.

#### **BACKGROUND**

In 2019, the *Water Supply (Safety and Reliability) Act 2008* (the Act) was amended. One of the key changes to Section 161 of the Act was the requirement for service providers to formally declare service areas (for reticulated water and/or sewerage) through a Council resolution. Prior to this amendment, declaring a service area was voluntary.

A declaration of service area is required if a local government supplies a reticulated water service or sewerage service in all or part of the local government area (a relevant area). By resolution the local government must make this declaration. The declaration must be published on the local government's website and made available for inspection and purchase. After the declaration, the local government must, as soon as practicable, produce a map which details the service area boundaries for water and/or sewerage services and identify the location of the service providers' infrastructure.

Council first adopted the declared water and sewer service areas at an Ordinary Council Meeting dated 11 February 2020, a subsequent update was approved by Council on 22

February 2022. Over the following years the boundaries of the water and sewerage network areas within the Douglas Shire have been published on the Douglas Shire Council's website. As part of the most recent review, additional land parcels have been identified for inclusion within the declared network area (see attachments 7.2.1 to 7.2.8 for updated boundary maps).

Boundary maps were developed by identifying properties that are currently subject to water and sewer rates. This data was then mapped, and the boundaries were created through a complex process involving careful analysis of every parcel of land.

#### **COMMENTS**

Officers in the Water and Wastewater Business Unit have undertaken a review of the declared water and sewerage network service area boundaries. The review resulted in no changes to sewer service areas. The following properties have been identified for inclusion within the Water Service Area.






## Non Potable Lower, Daintree (De Meio) -Water Network Area-






## Killaloe and Cassowary -Water Network Area-





