RECOMMENDATION

That, as the petition is of an operational nature, Council resolves to receive the petition and refer it to the Chief Executive Officer to investigate the need to install a traffic control calming device at or close to 30 Marlin Drive and for the project be considered in the 2019/2020 budget if warranted.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

A Petition has been received by Council and, in accordance with Clause 8.1 of the Standing Orders for Council Meetings, is presented to Council.

The Petition is requesting Council to install a traffic control speed bump at or close to 30 Marlin Drive.

The Principal Petitioner is Gregory Michael Tarrant of 30 Marlin Drive. The petition has been signed by 20 petitioners (refer Attachment 1).

COMMENT

The Petition suggests that Marlin Drive is poorly designed, (long, wide and straight) with vehicles constantly exceeding the 50kph speed limit, endangering children and all residents.
