

8.2. PETITION FOR PROPOSAL TO INSTALL SPEED BUMPS IN LUND STREET MOSSMAN GORGE

RECOMMENDATION

That the Petition for the proposal to install Speed Bumps in Lund Street, Mossman Gorge be received.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Petition had been received by Council's Community Liaison Officer, and in accordance with clause 5 of the Standing Orders for Council Meetings, the Petition is presented to Council.

The principal petitioner is the Bamanga Bubu Ngadimunku Aboriginal Corporation (BBNAC) Board on behalf of the Mossman Gorge Community, having received 52 signatures in support of the Board to reinstate the speed humps in the Lund Street.

COMMENT

Council received a request from the BBNAC Board in January 2020 to reinstate two speed bumps in Lund Street. The speed humps were removed when a new surface was laid on the road pavement.

Douglas Shire Council staff did a site inspection and agreed there was a need for some speed reduction measures and suggested two raised platforms.

To ascertain if reinstatement of the two speed humps was supported by residents in the Mossman Gorge Community, Council prepared a notice which was distributed to the 30 homes in the community.

In response to the question of whether residents agreed or not, Council has received a petition with 52 signatures in support of the speed humps.

There have been no objections to the speed humps received.



On behalf of the BBNAC Board and residents of the Mossman Gorge, I respectfully request that the Douglas Shire Council reinstate the two traffic speed reduction devices on Lund Street within the community.
