


Radar's family is learning about wild weather. Severe weather can strike unexpectedly and do a lot of damage quickly. That's why it's super important to be prepared.










NATURAL 0

Thunderstorm






Bushfire

Radar's family also has a list of phone numbers for their neighbours, the SES, fire fighters, police and doctors, in case they need help.








When the weather presenter announces a storm is coming, Radar's family prepares their home and tidies up items that could blow away.

First aid kit




Lead and collar




Waste bags


