#### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

At the Ordinary Council Meeting 20 November 2018 Council resolved to adopt a new Organisational Structure. The change to the structure resulted in the removal of the two General Manager roles and the creation of nine direct reports to the CEO. All management titles were changed.

#### COMMENT

Although a number of Council's policies have been updated in the last six months, the majority of policies still contain outdated titles for Management.
