EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

A petition has been received by the Chief Executive Officer from the residents and visitors to Douglas Shire requesting improved access to Four Mile Beach.

This petition was initiated by a resident who requires wheelchair access to community facilities.

COMMENT

The project will involve the design and construction of a beach access ramp.

PROPOSAL

That the CEO consider the request and includes this project in the draft 2016-17 Capital Works Budget for Council review and consideration.

This is a cover letter to present with my petition explaining how I got involved with the Douglas Shire Council and the reason for doing this petition. I moved up here two and half years ago wanting to live in a smaller community lifestyle and move away from a big town... like many of us seeking a sea change. Seeing the beach up here and watching all the people with families and dogs enjoying the beautiful sunshine and cool waters, laying on the sand and generally soaking up the atmosphere was my dream. The question in my head constantly is: "if only I could get onto that beach."?

After many attempts trying desperately with an electric wheelchair to access the beach I discovered it was just impossible, actually got myself bogged up to 3 times, and once behind the Ramada which was a scary frustrating experience waiting for help. I was fortunate that people were around to literally pull my heavy chair out of sand. Over this period of time I have never been able to access the front beach which makes me sad and disappointed, after realising I had put so much time and effort, money into moving up here from Townsville.

After attending the International Women's Day Lunch in 2015 I spoke to Julia Leu our Mayor regarding this problem and having no wheelchair access to the beach. Julia was interested in promoting Port Douglas to be more accessible, she agreed with my ideas and then put me in contact with Brendan Leishman to help me with this project. In next 12 months I recontacted the Council as in 2015 I found myself busy being involved with the Clink Theatre performances. This meant after the ramp at the back of the Clink Theatre was installed, I had access in and out of theatre safely and independently in my electric wheelchair. This gave me more opportunity to get involved with the local theatre attending several performances, which finally made me feel I was a part of our small community.

Early this year I decided it was time to email Brendan Leishman asking him if we could get together to talk about these issues concerning the beach. He arranged a couple of meetings at my unit here in Port Douglas discussing a plan be put in action so we both came up with Step 1: a Petition to be signed by everyone, showing the interest and need for access on our beach.

In February 2016 I ventured out many times a week, night and day in heat, rain and dark pursuing as many signatures as I could. I was totally out of my comfort zone stopping people on the streets, entering shops and pubs, outside Coles three times asking for signatures in all types of weather. Yes I certainly got some NOs but it was the YES responses I was looking for, kept working hours knowing this is a very worthwhile cause, meeting some beautiful people. After many weeks it came to my attention that I was raising awareness to people that made comments about the lack of access here in PD.

I had many brief chats with people sharing short stories about members of family, friends and acquaintances that had come up here and couldn't access the beach. The responses, comments, support and encouragement was unbelievably overwhelming and people were happy to sign my petition for a positive change. When I counted 500 signatures, 700, 800 I couldn't believe it was only a matter of time. With every signature I became more excited and thrilled to see and hear people's attitudes on this matter. Working hard over a period of three months I have completed my petition, now presenting to the council over 1000 signatures, reaching my goal and grateful for the much needed help I achieved from the community.

Brendan Leishman is a delight to work with and has been very supportive, understanding and passionate about getting wheelchair access infrastructure on our beach. I believe that our determination, dedication and compassion for this strong belief for everyone will be appreciated not only disabled people, children, mothers and fathers with prams and strollers, elderly and frail, those with health conditions and special needs will benefit all our community of locals and tourists. This project when completed will change people's lives giving them opportunities, enjoyment and recreation with their families, friends, and individuals with assistance carer's by having wheelchair access on our beach.

My motto is “everybody has a right to the beach” and that is my passion to see things change for the better for people with disabilities, equal rights and equality, accessible places to feel and see what everybody else on the beach is enjoying. I know many organisations, services and centres are fighting for us for inclusion not exclusion!!

I personally feel that all the public should be able to access the beach which could improve the emotional wellbeing in people's lives. This would allow a happy healthy experience and promote great water therapy for many. I feel the more wheelchair access this town can provide for better living, long-term accommodation, access to shopping, restaurants, toilets, swimming pools and tourist attractions would be beneficial to everyone. This could boost local businesses by adding awareness of this feature and encouraging tourists to visit here accessing our beautiful Four Mile Beach.
