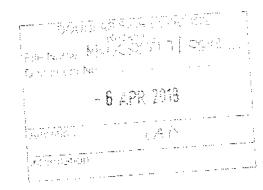

I have been engaged by the owner, Mr J. Cocks, to provide plans suitable for building approval for structural alterations that have been carried out without approval. The development consists of 2 units under separate building unit titles, and it is the front unit under scrutiny.

Plans of the development are attached and show that the original garage has been converted to a third bedroom with ensuite. A covered car park has been relocated to the front of the building and is reasonably hidden from view. The site in general is provided with an acceptable amount of established mature vegetation and open recreation areas.

An assessment of the 2018 planning scheme indicates the building work is assessable against the planning scheme due to the reduced front setback of the relocated covered carpark. Below is a request to allow the breach within the Low-Medium density residential zone code.

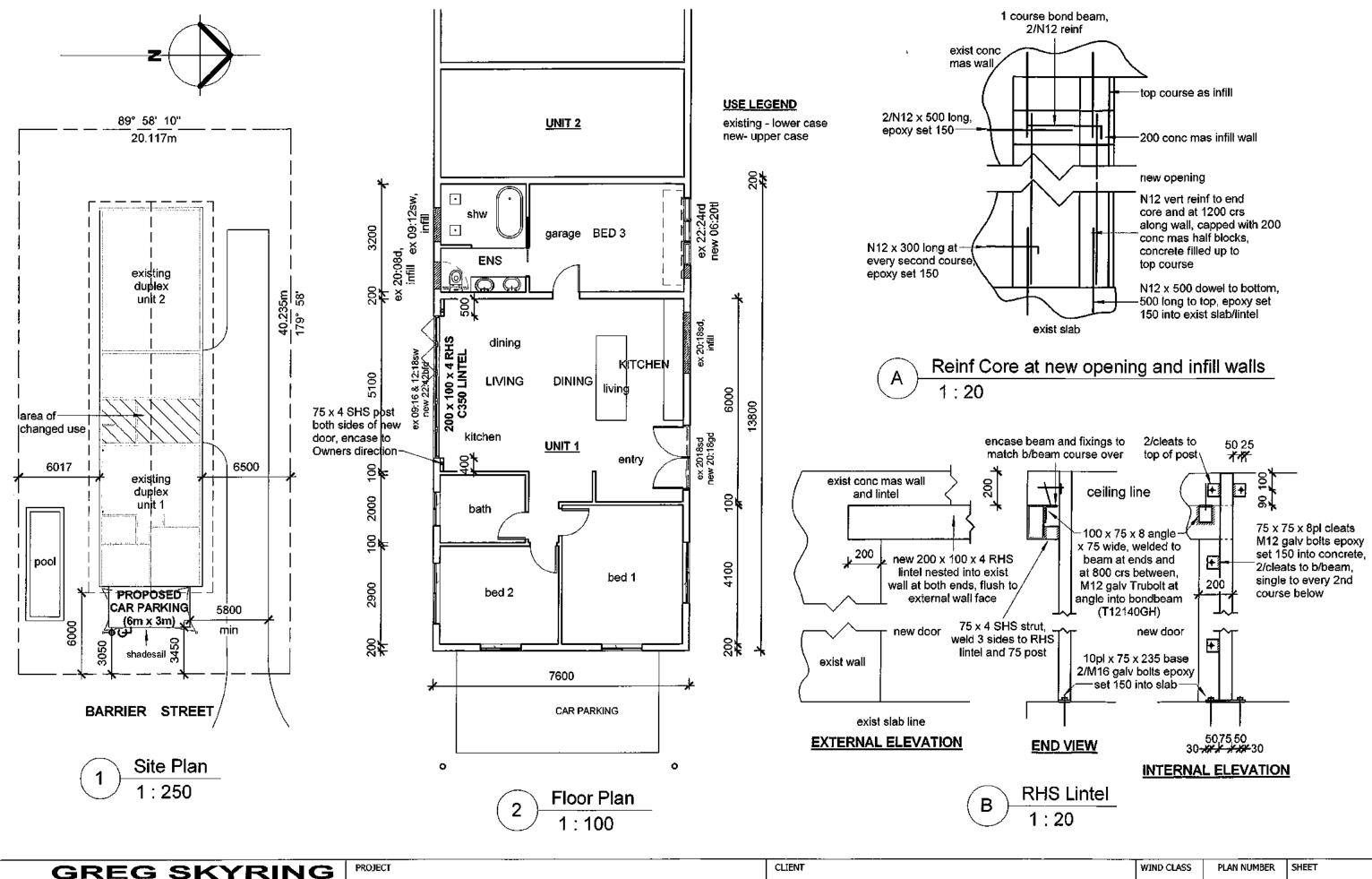

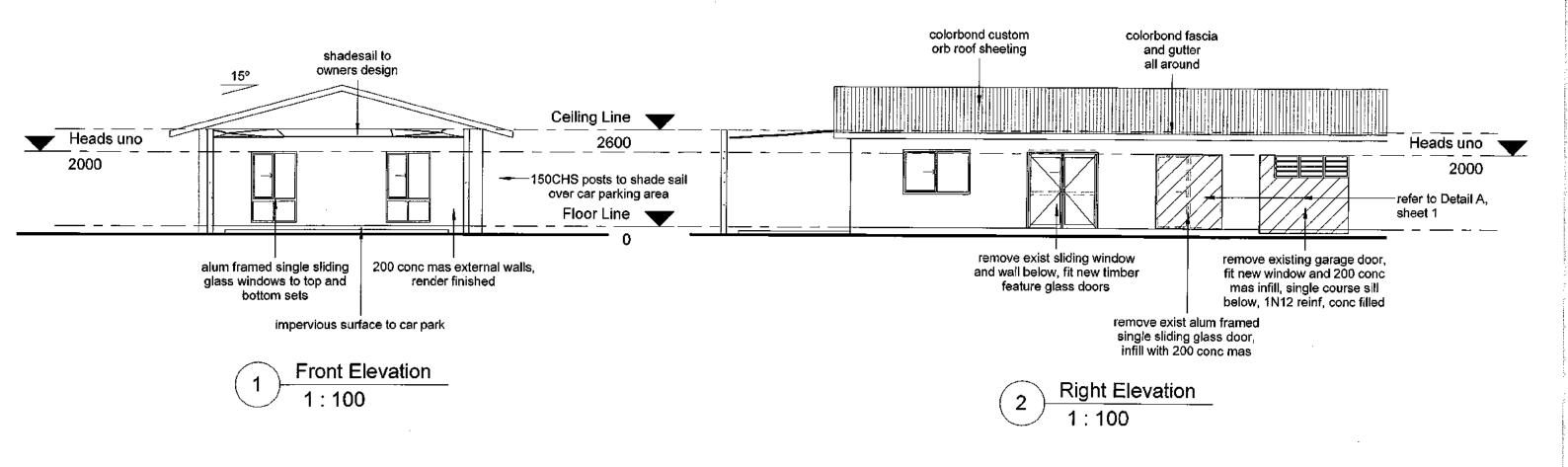

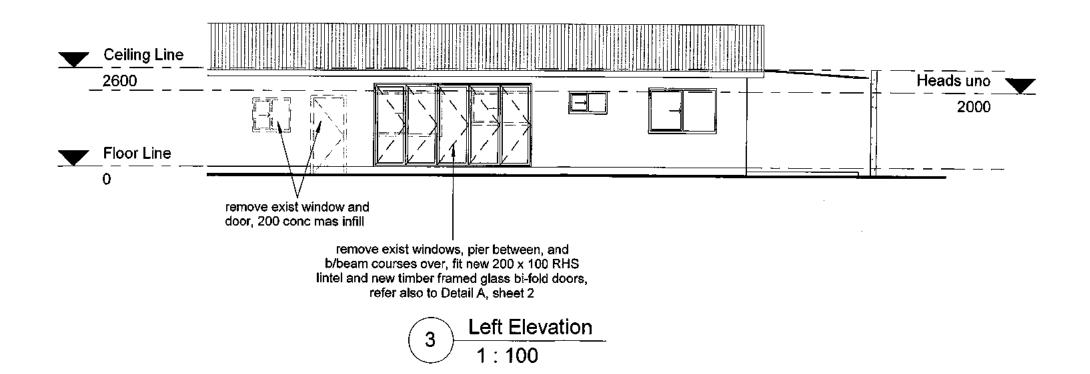
