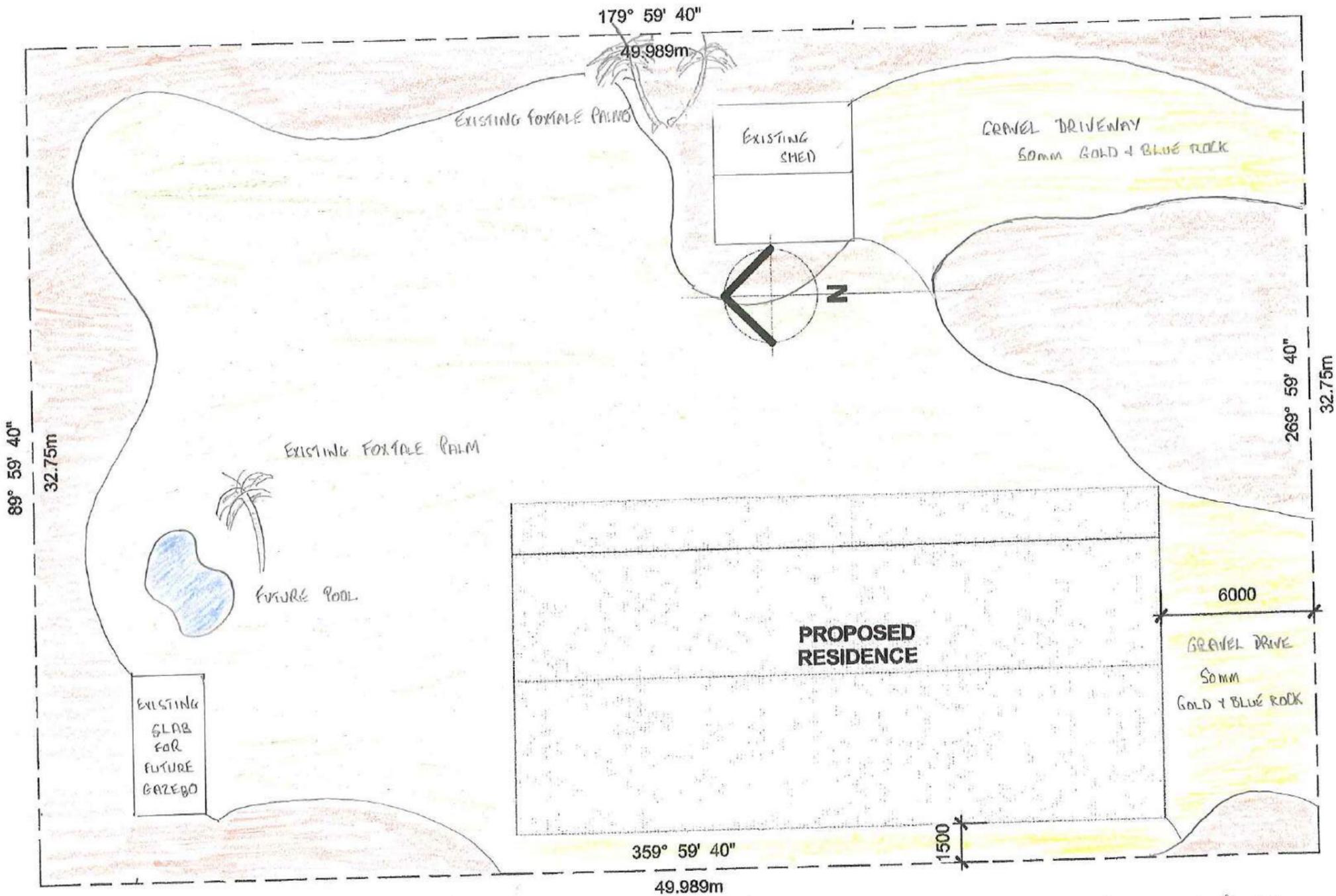

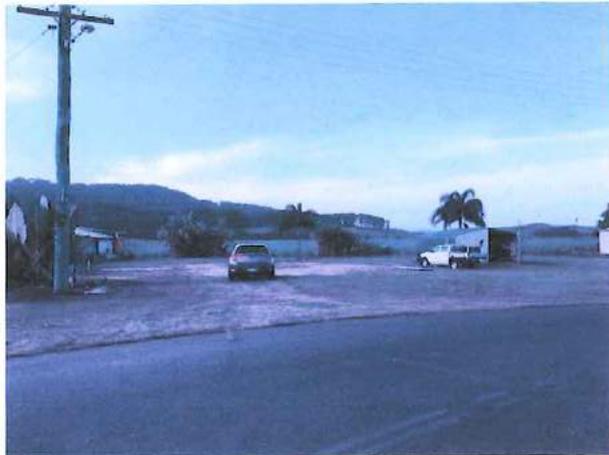

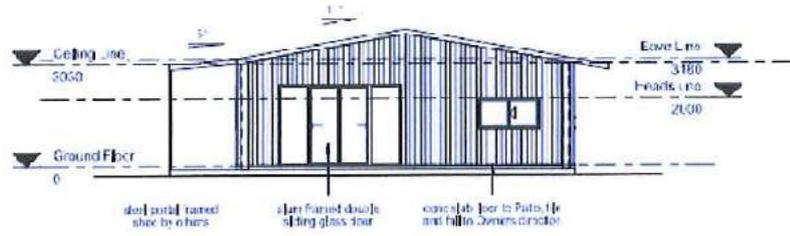
As per photo below, there is not an existing curb and channel guttering to this end of Atherton Street



As per the Rural Settlement Planning Area Code we will -maintain the semi-rural character of settlement areas, ensure that Landscaping enhances the visual quality and unique identity of the Shire by featuring endemic vegetation and the planting of approximately 300 native trees and shrubs. (Please see attached landscape plan). All shrubs chosen will require little water, other than seasonal rainfall, once established. We will build a low-set, colorbond steel home. Wall colour shall be Dulux Colorbond color, Dune, with the roof color being Woodland Grey. These colors are non-reflective and will minimise the impact on the environment and the Scenic Amenity values of the area and ensuring the landscape will screen the building to a large extent. A 6.2 kw solar system will also be installed in order to lessen our environmental impact. There will be approximately 250 square meters of garage and driveway space on the property to park at least a dozen vehicles.

As the attached Google Maps photo shows, there was a house on this property that burnt down approximately 5 years ago. We are proposing to build our house basically on the same footprint as the old house. There is sewerage, storm water drain and water to our block.





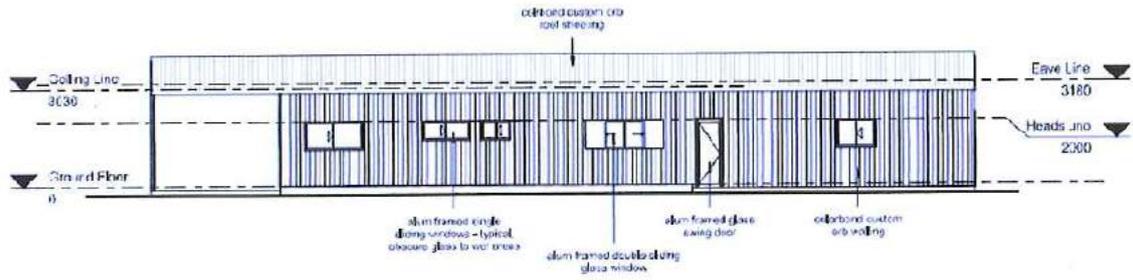

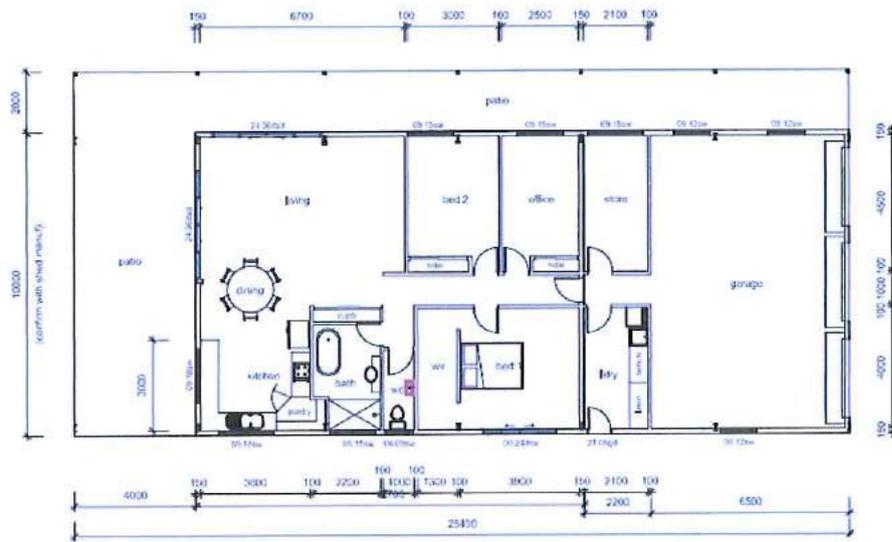


2 Left Elevation
