### Flood & storm tide hazard overlay code

The property is partly affected by the Floodplain Assessment Overlay. However, there is no evidence the property has ever been affected by the Flood and Storm Tide – Medium Hazard Overlay.

The existing surface levels where the proposed house and bedroom wing are to be situated are 3.4-3.75mAHD and 3.6-3.8mAHD, respectively.
