Regarding the current Material Change of Use Application CA 2760/2018, I write on behalf of our client Daintree Saltwater Barramundi, and following receipt of correspondence by SARA.

SARA have advised:

The Department of Agriculture and Fisheries has recommended the preferred approach would be to include the entire aquaculture operation in one approval, and this will also negate any compliance issues with the current approval for the existing aquaculture operation.

It was intended for the MCU application to achieve one Aquaculture approval/permit for the entire Aquaculture operation. Therefore, please consider this letter to be a formal request to amend and/or clarify the existing MCU application.

The application for a Material Change of Use is to include the existing and proposed new production ponds, settlement ponds, drains and the wetland treatment area comprising the whole aquaculture operation. Attachment 1 to this letter sets out an overall plan and extent of the whole aquaculture operation. To further avoid any doubt and clarify the intent, the application is made on the basis that one Aquaculture approval will be granted for the whole aquaculture operation on Lot 3 and as such the aquaculture approval SPD-0515-017379 dated 5 June 2015 will be amended or replaced by the new approval.

Conclusion

We trust the above can be accepted by Council as a formal representation to amend and/or clarify the MCU application. We seek Councils confirmation of acceptance of this amendment/clarification.
