Morning,

I am writing to get further information regarding the proposed Development adjacent to Crees Creek.

While I understand we have a huge need for accommodation for workers, I question the thinking behind making such a large project in an area next to a peaceful residential street, especially now that we no longer have cane, therefore leaving vast areas open for such a development.

My main concern is primarily around noise.

-Will the caretaker on site have the authority to keep noise to a reasonable level and in keeping with the Shires current noise restrictions?

-If excessive after 10pm, will we (the residents) have a number we can call to have it dealt with? (don't say Police because I doubt they would bother with this)

My other query is around the affect on the water level of the creek seeing as I back onto it, I really worry about wet season if the development does indeed get the ground level raised. Where will the run off go?

Last point brought to our attention is around the sewerage, and what will be in place so the 150 extra buildings (potentially 300 more people) to handle this extra stress on the existing system.
