Proposed Reconfiguration of Lot (42 Residential Allotments, Parks & New Roads) Application

## I refer to:

- the above application received at the Department 25 May 2006 requesting consideration of the above development,
- the Department's information request included in the North Queensland Planning Branch letter of Finalised Information Request - Amended, dated 14 July 2006, and
- written request from the applicant's consultant received at the Department 9 November 2006 for reconsideration of the 4 items of additional information sought by the Department.

## The Department has considered the request and advises:

- a recent traffic survey of the local section of the Mossman-Daintree Road conducted by the Department of Main Roads recommends maintaining the existing 100kph speed limit,
- a review of provisions relating to the subject land in the transitional planning scheme, particularly as Special Area 1 in Development Control Plan 4, sections 5.4.10.2 (2), (4) and (5), which specify contour and vegetation surveys accompanying the application (still outstanding) to ensure retention of a broad vegetation screen along the Mossman-Daintree Road frontage and which also specify only one access to Mossman-Daintree Road,
- a review of provisions relating to the subject land in the gazetted Douglas Shire IPA scheme, particularly Rural Areas & Rural Settlements Locality Code, sections P10 and A10.1, which specify residential development on the more gently sloping part of the land elevated above the steep bank adjacent to Mossman-Daintree Road, contour and vegetation surveys accompanying the application (still outstanding) to ensure retention of a broad vegetation screen along the Mossman-Daintree Road frontage and which also specify only one access to Mossman-Daintree Road, and
- a review of provisions relating to the subject land in the gazetted Douglas Shire IPA scheme, particularly Reconfiguring a Lot Code, Table 1, which specify a minimum area of 3,500m2 for lots created in the Residential 1 Planning Area.

Consequently, the Queensland Department of Main Roads, as a Concurrence Agency, maintains that

- The Development Control Plan 4 Special Area 1 requirement of contour and vegetation surveys
  to accompany the proposed reconfiguration of the subject land, inter alia, to confirm that 3
  access points are justified as the DMR standard policy is only one point of access,
- DMR verbal advice to the applicant's consultants 25 August 2005 that suggested 3 proposed intersections for the subject land be located a <u>minimum 250m apart</u> and with adequate site distances for the 100kph speed limit of Mossman-Daintree Road,
- That a Type BAR1 intersection can be accommodated at each proposed access point for the proposed development, and
- DMR condition in letter 1 July 1999 for previous reconfiguration application creating Lot 11 on SP 132055 requiring a 40m building alignment setback from the Mossman-Daintree Road frontage for all new structures on the subject land (impacts on 10 proposed residential allotments).
