We act for the owners of the above property and attach a Material Change of Use Application for alterations to the existing residential units on the allotment.

The proposal, which is the subject of this application, is to renovate the existing 2 accommodation units to the rear of the property. The improvements include:

- Ground Floor Increase the size of the patio, construct a bedroom to the rear of the unit and provide a covered car space.
- 1st Floor Basic renovation with no change in area.

Accordingly, the application for Material Change of Use is enclosed for Council's assessment, which includes:

- 1. Forms 1 & 5
- 2. 1 x copy of plans
- 3. A cheque for Council's scheduled fee of \$860.95

Proposal

The property is located within the Port Douglas Commercial Planning Area (Local Centre) pursuant to the Douglas Shire Planning Scheme. Existing improvements to the property include a restaurant and 2 x residential units.

The proposal does not include a change or intensification of the use of the premises. Essentially, the proposal complies with the Douglas Shire Planning Scheme in all respects other than the proposed setback to the rear boundary. Other issues that we have addressed to demonstrate compliance include, car-parking and stormwater drainage.

2. Car-parking Compliance

The attached site plan illustrates the floor areas of the buildings, car-parking layout and includes carparking calculations. The proposal complies with the Car-parking Code.

3. On-site Stormwater Management

The land slopes from the Davidson Street frontage down to the rear of the property. The allotment has not been provided with inter-allotment drainage. Subsequently, the development relies on on-site stormwater management complying with AS3500.3 – Stormwater Drainage. On-site management of stormwater drainage for the proposal as there is sufficient area to the north-western corner of the allotment to facilitate continued satisfactory disposal.

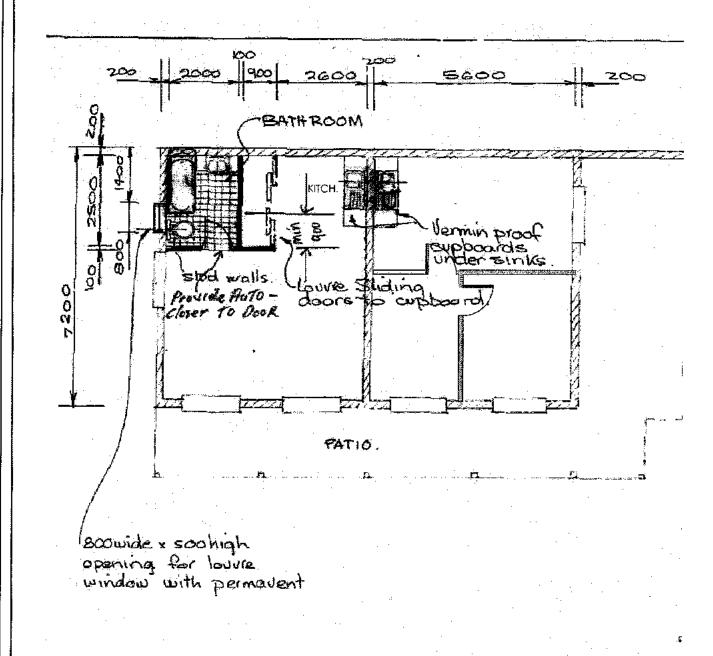

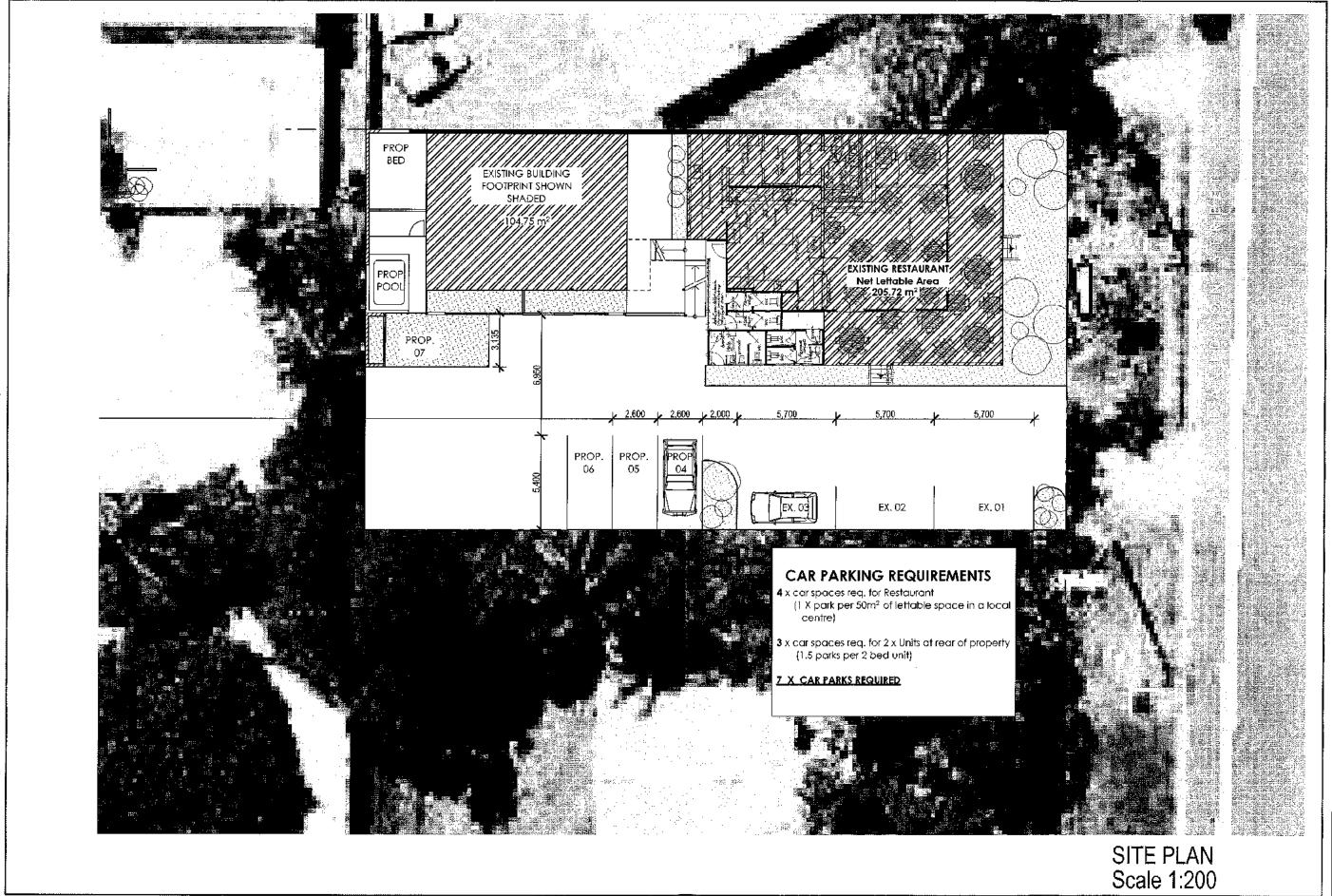
