Please find attached correspondence regarding the information request received 13 October 2015.

The below details correspond to your request for further information regarding my MCU proposal for electronic mountain bike tours. Numbers correspond to the numbered questions you sent.

3. Tracks are to be maintained by hand labour only (shovel and rake), no machinery will be required for maintenance. The tracks are separated into a basic loop and an experienced loop that includes a crossing of Myall creek.  
When utilizing the experienced loop, crossing Myall creek, the groups will be Stopping and walking all bikes through the waterway environment. This will minimise disturbance to the waterway by eliminating the potential high impact shock to the water, caused by bikes travelling at speed. Note that the creek is seasonal and rarely contains flowing water more than 20cm deep.
4. No trail markings are proposed, they are not necessary as it is a guided loop tour. The existing trails are substantially wide and easy to follow.
5. The trails may be subject to standard mountain bike use for maintenance. However, no standard mountain bike use is proposed for the tour operations.
6. We plan to be open seven days per week, with tours operating between 7am-6pm.
7. All tour guides operating the tour are required to carry a first aid kit and to hold current first aid certificates as per our insurance plan. This is coupled with 2way/UHF radio service to Mason's Store in case of an emergency.
