Dear Donna,

Thank you for getting back to us regarding the information request for a MCU on 1082R Mossman – Daintree Road, Rocky Point.

Below you will find responses to the information required:

- The application coincides with the Marine Park Permit which I have attached. See Appendix A
 The conditions associated with this permit and those that the permit was approved by are included in the Activity Management Plan attached. See Appendix B. We are permitted by Marine Parks to have a max of 8 horses on the beach at one time.
- The Horse stable and registration building will be as apart of the existing building. No further buildings or structures will be erected for these purposes.
- 3. The Carpark area will now be located, as discussed at the meeting held on site, behind the existing shed. See **Appendix C** for the location of proposed car park and training/instruction area.
 - The training/ instruction area as seen on **Appendix D** will be approximately 8m diameter enclosed arena. The Car Park is proposed for behind the shed as seen on **Appendix E**, and shown in scale in relation to the existing shed on **Appendix F**.
- 4. The training/instruction area will be made from portable panels and can be removed at any point in time. The panels are 2.5 metres long and 2 metres high. Gates will be included in the arena t allow easy yet safe entry and exit.
- No upgrade works are proposed for the existing construction of the shed. Portable panels will be used to construct the stables inside the shed.
- The advertising planned for the entrance to the property will be a sign erected approx 2.5 m wide and 1.5 m high. The artwork for this sign has not been completed at this date, however we will forward to the council once completed.



7. No other building located on the property will be used for the operation of the Horse Trail Rides.
