This is an email to strongly oppose the proposed helicopter airport, hangar, accommodation, and refueling station at the Yule Point locality.

Yule Point is of immense biological and cultural values, is a known dugong habitat, and is a special place for Port Douglas families and visitors to experience the wonders of the mangrove ecosystems and inshore reef habitat.

Helicopters coming and going all day is not in line with the natural values of this locality, nor for the residents of Mowbray, Pebbly Beach, and Oak Beach that will be impacted by helicopter traffic.

There is already an airport north of Port Douglas, a landing strip near Newell Beach, and one near the Sheraton that perfectly accommodates all airport needs. There is simply no reasonable reason why this location should be an airport. It makes absolutely no sense.
