This area is a culturally and biologically important area (home to many seabirds, a feeding site for vulnerable dugongs and marine turtles, along with a plethora of other animals that are important to maintaining healthy marine and intertidal ecosystems) which will be negatively impacted by the proposed development and associated air traffic. This development of an airport, hangar, accommodation and refueling station seems completely superfluous as there are already facilities in the shire to meet these needs. I would also like to know if this proposal is intended to be part of the 'Port Douglas Wave Park'?
